I heard I can reduce my taxes by paying for Full-Day K!

Here's How:

- Families can apply Arizona Tax Credit toward kindergarten tuition. This is a dollar—for—dollar credit against your tax amount.
- Individuals can pay up to \$200 and married couples filing jointly can pay up to \$400 applied toward tuition as an Arizona tax credit in a single calendar year.
- Anybody can designate their tax credit to be used for your child's tuition.
- Since the school year is split over two calendar years, an individual or married couple could pay up to the maximum tax credit amount for kindergarten tuition and deduct up to the limit in both years 2011 and 2012.

Please consult with your tax advisor to verify how this would apply in individual cases.



How can my child get to & from Kindergarten?

Buses will run for AM & PM and Full-Day Kindergarten. An adult must be present when your child gets off the bus. Schedules will be available before school begins.

How do I know which school my child should attend?

- Kindergarten students must enroll at the school within attendance boundaries of their home address. Proof of residence is required.

Exceptions:

Parents of kindergarten students who are enrolled on a full tuition bases may pick school of attendance (space permitting). (Open Enrollment Form Required)

Kindergarten students who have a sibling already attending the school of choice. (Open Enrollment Form Required)

- Requests for Open Enrollment can be made following district policy, but decisions for in-district transfers may be made as late as September 5, 2011.

Is there a cost for Half Day Kindergarten?

- There is no charge for Half-Day Kindergarten.
- Students will be assigned to the morning or afternoon session. Parents may indicate preference but the district will make the final decision.

How much does Full-Day Kindergarten Cost?

(Based on eligibility—Free / Reduced Lunch)

- **Full Tuition:**
\$1,440.00 at Daily Rate: \$10.00
- **Reduced Lunch Qualification (25%):**
\$360.00 at Daily Rate: \$2.50
- **Free Lunch Qualification (10%):**
\$144.00 at Daily Rate: \$1.00

Will there be food available at school for Half-Day Students?

Breakfast or snack will be provided, depending on hours of attendance.
